- Gloves

Technology (Industrial Technology):

1. Most equipment can be purchased from general stores or newsagents
2. Some equipment can be expected to last for five years of secondary school life (eg calculator, drawing set and stapler).
3. Please label all equipment.
4. Loganlea State High School provides a Homework Diary for each student who is part of the Resources Scheme. Students will need to pay for a replacement if the diary is lost.
5. Extra A4 Exercise books will be needed at times during the year for some subjects. It may be more economical to purchase more of these at the beginning of the year when prices are cheaper.
6. Workbooks and/or worksheets are issued in most subjects. If a workbook is lost or damaged, a replacement will need to be provided at the student's expense.
7. Students will need a dictionary for home use.
