BYODx Overview

At Loganlea State High School, we incorporate technology to enhance our thought; develop technological efficacy; strengthen our organisation and collaboration skills; differentiate for students who need support or challenge; engage our students and support our ability to inquire.

Bring Your Own 'x' (BYODx) is a pathway supporting the delivery of 21st century learning. It is a term used to describe a digital device ownership model where students or staff use their personally-owned mobile devices to access the department's information and communication (ICT) network.

The BYODx acronym used by the department refers to the teaching and learning environment in Queensland state schools where personally-owned laptop devices are used. The 'x' in BYODx represents more than a personally-owned device; it also includes software, applications, connectivity or carriage services.

Specifications of BYODx Device

Loganlea SHS recommends that all devices used by students meet the minimum specifications below to enable suitability for curriculum-based activities.

- **Screen size:** As this is a tool used in the classroom, it is impractical to have a screen that is too small. **Minimum screen size of 10 inches is required.**
- **Keyboard:** A physical keyboard is recommended to increase available screen space, and typing accuracy.
- **Connectivity:** Students will connect to the LSHS network via Wi-Fi. Access to the internet outside this is achieved via your home Wi-Fi network.

Other Considerations

- **Padded Carry Case:** The school recommends a separate case to the standard school bag. These are available for purchase at The School Locker.
- **Extended Warranty:** Many manufacturers offer an extended warranty for up to three years after the date of purchase to protect against hardware failures/defects.
- **Laptop Insurance:** Used to protect against theft, accidental damage (dropped, liquid spills, falling off the roof of moving vehicles, etc.) The school highly recommends that you review your Home and Contents Insurance policy. Other insurance options are available when purchasing the device with companies including The School Locker.
- **School Lunchtime Storage:** Loganlea SHS has rentable student lockers that can be used during school breaks for students in Years 7-12. The cost is **\$10** a term or **\$30** for the year (must be paid in Term 1).
- **Subject selection:** Students studying technical or creative subjects will benefit from a higher performance device.

Unsupported Devices

The following are not compatible with the school network. These devices cannot be used at school.

- Chromebooks
- Linux devices
- Android devices
- Windows laptops with Snapdragon processors



Device Care

The student is responsible for taking care of and securing the device and accessories in accordance with school policy and guidelines. **Responsibility for loss or damage of a device at home, in transit or at school belongs to the student.** Advice should be sought regarding inclusion in home and contents insurance policy.

It is advised that **accidental damage and warranty policies** are discussed at point of purchase to minimise financial impact and disruption to learning should a device not be operational.

General Precautions

- Food or drink should never be placed near the device.
- Plugs, cords and cables should be inserted and removed carefully.
- Devices should be carried within their protective case where appropriate.
- Carrying devices with the screen open should be avoided.
- Ensure the battery is fully charged each day.
- Turn the device off before placing it in its bag.

BYODx Equity Device Application Form

Dear Parents / Caregivers,

The purpose of the BYODx Equity Policy is to establish the framework for the BYODx program to provide this for all students, irrespective of their families' financial circumstances.

We recognise that the BYODx program raises a financial cost on students and their families in supplying a device. At the same time, the program can only function if all students have access to appropriate technological resources in all of their classes.

From 2025, the Equity Program will include a \$100 yearly hiring fee. The hiring fee can be paid in termly instalments of \$25 per term.

Please select your preference from the following options:

- I will provide my own device for my child
- I do not have the resources to supply a device for my child at this time and would like to **hire** a device through the BYODx equity program for **\$100 a year**.

I have read the responsibilities listed on the following page and I have read and agree to the indemnity information.

Where a loan laptop is damaged due to negligence or not returned, the parent/caregiver will be contacted and issued an invoice to pay the repair or replacement cost. This arrangement allows student from families in financial hardship to access a laptop until circumstances improve and a personal laptop is purchased.

Indemnity

Fair wear and tear excepted, and for the duration of this transfer, I/we agree to indemnify Department of Education against loss or damage from any cause whatsoever, to the equipment detailed herein and, in the event of damage to restore and deliver such equipment to Department of Education, in the condition in which it was received, or to replace the damaged equipment with other equipment of equivalent functionality.

- If the hire device is broken, I will organise through Loganlea State High School for the device to be repaired: **Screen \$217.80, Cover \$15, Keyboard \$45, Battery \$66.67, Charger \$32.88. These fees are in addition to the \$100 hiring fee.**
- **The \$100 hiring fee is to be paid by Week 3, Term 1 in full unless a payment plan has been identified.**
- If the device is stolen or broken beyond repair, I will pay Loganlea State High school **\$250.00** to replace the device, knowing my child will receive a new long-term hire agreement.
- When my child departs or graduates Loganlea State High School, they will return the laptop to the school. I understand that failure to do so will result in a **\$250 charge** and that if payment is not received the device will be reported stolen and referred to the Police.
- The device is to be returned at the end of each school year.

Equity Laptop - Student Agreement
