Under this agreement for 2020 Loganlea State High School

\$559,766

This funding will be used to

- Maintain 100% QCE and VET completion and improve Post School Destination data - Engagement in education, training or employment from 65.6% to 80%.
- Employ a Dean of Students, Youth Engagement Officer and Youth Support Worker who will work with existing staff in the school to drive Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) and implement whole school case management to improve student attendance and engagement with the following targets:
 - Improving attendance from 82.4% to 92%.
 - Reduce 1-10 day suspensions from 14.2 per 100 students/per term to below 12
 - Reduce 11-20 day suspensions from 1.8 per 100 students/per term to below 1.5
 - Reduce Daily Incident Behaviours from 2.7 incidents per 100 students to below 2
- Employ three teacher aides to implement the multilit program for at need students to improve reading skills and allow them to achieve C or better throughout their National Curriculum subjects.
- Employ a Teaching and Learning Head of Department that will lead the implementation of a new Pedagogical Framework – AVID, with a core focus in 2020 on improving students organisational skills leading to improved academic outcomes:
 - Improve OneSchool Academic Reporting data for A's from 9.2% to 12%
 - Improve OneSchool Academic Reporting data for A-C from 81.4% to 85%

Our initiatives include

- Tracking, monitoring and supporting senior students to achieve QCE and ensure all students have a detailed and viable plan of action for when they graduate Year 12. This includes every Year 12 student having a Plan A and Plan B for when they graduate.
- Implement a new pedagogical framework – AVID (Achievement Via Individual Determination) with a focus on student organisation through binder use and consistent note taking. Provide quality professional development and coaching for staff.
- Implement new behaviour expectations and “Scales of Behaviour” to improve consistency of behaviour management across the school.
- Implement whole school case management model to ensure every student has their behaviour, attendance and academic progress tracked.
- Build strong relationships with universities to attract excellent preservice teachers and provide them with support to ensure a smooth transition into teaching.
- Implement the cycle of inquiry at levels in the school to track progress of strategies and ensure the right work is being done.
- Implement SENTIS wellbeing program to help educate students around living a healthy life, physically and mentally.
