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LOGANLEA STATE HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

The Loganlea State High School provides a variety of scholarships to students in Years 7-12. Each scholarship applies for one calendar year. Scholarships are available for our STAR Programs:

1. Loganlea Institute of Sport (LIS)
2. Hospitality
3. Agribusiness (Agriculture)
4. Loganlea Youth Development Program (LYDP)
5. Dance
6. Signature (Academic)

Applicants must:

- have been accepted/offered entry to, or are currently enrolled at, Loganlea State High School in Years 7-12
- conform with the school's enrolment policy and meet the selection criteria established by the school
- be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, permanent resident of Australia or holder of an Australian permanent resident humanitarian visa
- have ongoing enrolment at Loganlea State High School (if the student leaves Loganlea State High School during the scholarship year, scholarship monies and/or program equipment may be required to be reimbursed)

The Scholarships Approval Process:

- assesses scholarship application on the basis of the selection criteria for the relevant STAR Program
- may award multiple scholarships when where student is eligible
- makes the final decision to award the scholarship
- Includes provision to discontinue a scholarship on grounds including failure to meet STAR program standards or withdrawal of the student from a STAR Program

Scholarship Applications for 2021 close on **Friday 6th November 2020**. *Applications received after this date may be assessed at the discretion of the relevant STAR Program Coordinator(s).*

Applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by the end of Term 4 2020

Scholarship Tiers:

Scholarships are granted under 3 tiers:, Gold, Silver, and Bronze. Successful applicants receive varying levels of support. This may range from financial (school fees, excursions), equipment and apparel. Levels are as follows:

Tier	Benefits
Gold	Provides students with school fees paid in full, STAR Program uniform, excursion costs and 1 school uniform provided
Silver	Provide students with school fees paid in full and STAR Program uniform
Bronze	Provide students with school fees paid in full

Note: Scholarships may differ from program-to-program depending on subject demands.

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Scholarship Procedures 2020

Selection criteria:

- Proven involvement/experience and expertise in discipline area.
- A positive behaviour and attendance record
- An excellent attitude towards schooling
- Proven record of involvement in extra-curricular activities
- Successful application and trial if required.

Selection Process:

- The enclosed application form must be completed by **student**.
- The application form must be returned to the school by **Friday 6th November 2020**. *Late applications may not be accepted. Refer to STAR Program Coordinator or Head of Department*
- All information and resources requested in the application form **MUST** be included with your application form
- The application form and supporting documentation will be assessed by the selection panel; consisting of the principal or delegate, STAR Program HOD, STAR Program Coordinator and STAR Program Facilitator.
- If a trial/trial period is required, information about this will be forwarded to you after lodgement of the forms.

Information for Parents/Carers:

- LSHS maintains high academic standards, encourages students to participate in a range of opportunities and has a supportive discipline and welfare structure.
- Students must commit to sign STAR Program Code of Conduct.
- An excellent attendance record is a prerequisite for scholarship recipients, including arriving at school on time.
- Parents/Carers of scholarship recipients are required to support their child's attendance at activities to support the broad range of opportunities offered by the school.
